Successes

European Best Practice guideline

In 2000 ESTA issued a Black book with a comprehensive list of different problems because of the lack of European harmonisation. In the Black book ESTA asked for European corridors for abnormal road transports. As a direct result the European Commission started with an EU Expert group who is responsible for a Best Practice Guideline. This document will provide member states and permit authorities with guidelines for permit procedures and regulations.

ESTA Awards

Every year the ESTA organises the ESTA awards ceremony and dinner where the ESTA awards for best lifting jobs and best transport jobs are made public.
